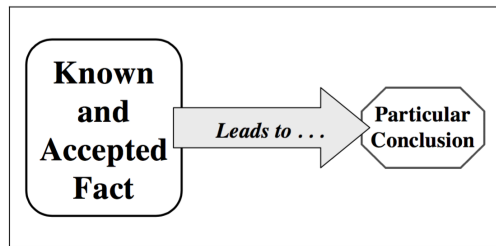

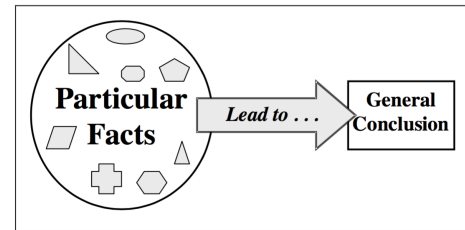

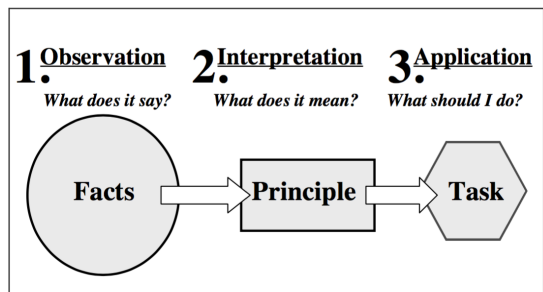

STEPS OF INDUCTIVE BIBLE STUDY

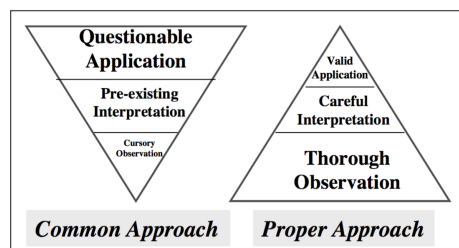
- What does it say? [**Observation**]
